PUMPS & PUMP DESIGN RELATED TO WATER PURIFICATION SYSTEMS (BOOSTER/RO/RE-PRESSURIZATION)

This month we will continue with the significant updates to the 2018 Michigan Plumbing Code:

Chapter 5 – Water Heaters

- *Section 502.1: Requirement for solar thermal water heating systems must now conform to the International Mechanical Code and ICC 900/SRCC 300. All the associated components shall also comply with the Code, otherwise the system cannot be considered complete.*
- *Section 504.7: Aluminum and plastic are included as approved materials for drain pans. Plastic drain pans, however, are prohibited for use with gas-fired water heaters.*

Chapter 6 - Water Supply and Distribution

- *Sections 605.13.7, 605.14.4, and 605.16.3: Language was added to clearly address push-fit method of joining piping materials.*
- *Section 607.3: Control devices for thermal expansion can be used in lieu of thermal expansion tanks to control hot water system pressures. While a calibrated pressure relief valve and combination ball and relief valve are examples of thermal expansion control devices, a temperature & pressure (T&P) relief valve is not. This is because T&P relief valves may become blocked from minerals when water is allowed to continuously drip.*
- *Section 608.4: The last sentence from Section 608.3 was moved to this section and reference to Sections 603.2 and 603.2.1 is now on Section 608.5 to provide more clarity about backflow protection requirements.*
- *Section 608.12: This section was added to address protection against contamination of drinking water in potable water tanks and compliance to NSF 61.*
- *Section 608.17.1.1: Each carbonated beverage dispenser must be provided with its own ASSE 1022 backflow preventer or air gap, even if multiple devices are fed from a single water supply connection. This section has requirements to prevent carbon dioxide gas from the reversing flow back into copper water supply pipes, which can cause leaching of copper into the potable water supply.*
- *Section 608.17.1.2: Similar to the previous section, each coffee machine and noncarbonated beverage dispensers must be provided with ASSE 1022 or ASSE 1024 backflow device, or an air gap; even when multiple devices are supplied from the one water connection.*
- *Section 608.17.10: This section was added to address backflow requirements for humidifiers. Humidifiers that do not have internal backflow protection must be provided with an ASSE 1012 backflow preventer or an air gap.*
- *Section 609.1: This section was updated to address specific health care fixtures and facilities, aligning with industry standards and the IBC.*
- *Section 611.1 Point-of use reverse osmosis drinking water treatment units must comply entirely with NSF 58 or CSA B483.1.*

CPD, would you like to know more?

CPD stands for Certified Plumbing Design. It's an accreditation offered by ASPE. To obtain the accreditation you must pass a 100 multiple choice question exam. The exam is an electronic proctored exam. To be eligible you should have four years of plumbing design experience. The exam is only offered once a year, with this year's window being between April 10 through 23.

The best way to register for the Certified in Plumbing Design examination is online. Go to <https://www.aspe.org/education-credentialing/cpd/exam/> to complete the eligibility form. After completion you will be sent an email with the link to register and pay fees for the exam.

The cost for ASPE Members is \$450 and \$650 for non-members.

As for why, the answer is pretty straight forward. It's really the only plumbing specific design certification I'm aware of. It should enhance your professional standing within your office and with your clients. To learn more, I'll direct you to the following ASPE web site: <https://www.aspe.org/education-credentialing/cpd/exam/>. I'll also recommend you reach out to a fellow ASPE member who have the accreditation. Many of your board members have passed the test and will be happy to give recommendations on how best to pass the test. A must will be the ASPE CPD Study Guide, as well as the primary ASPE books. There are also training classes available.

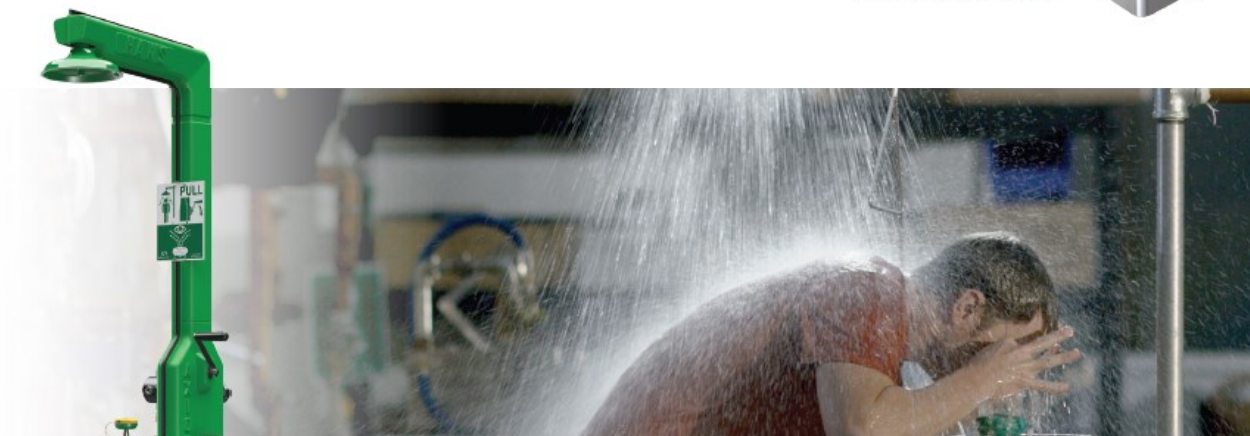
