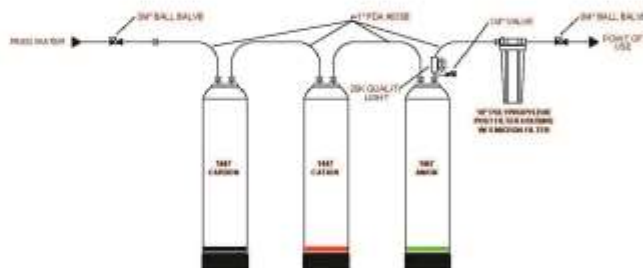

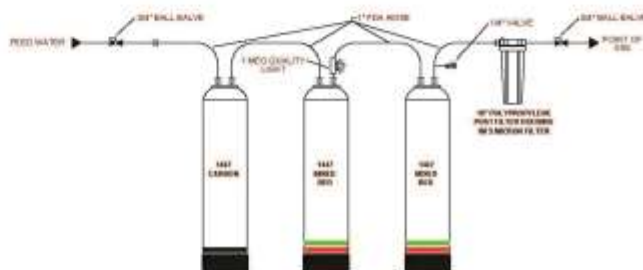

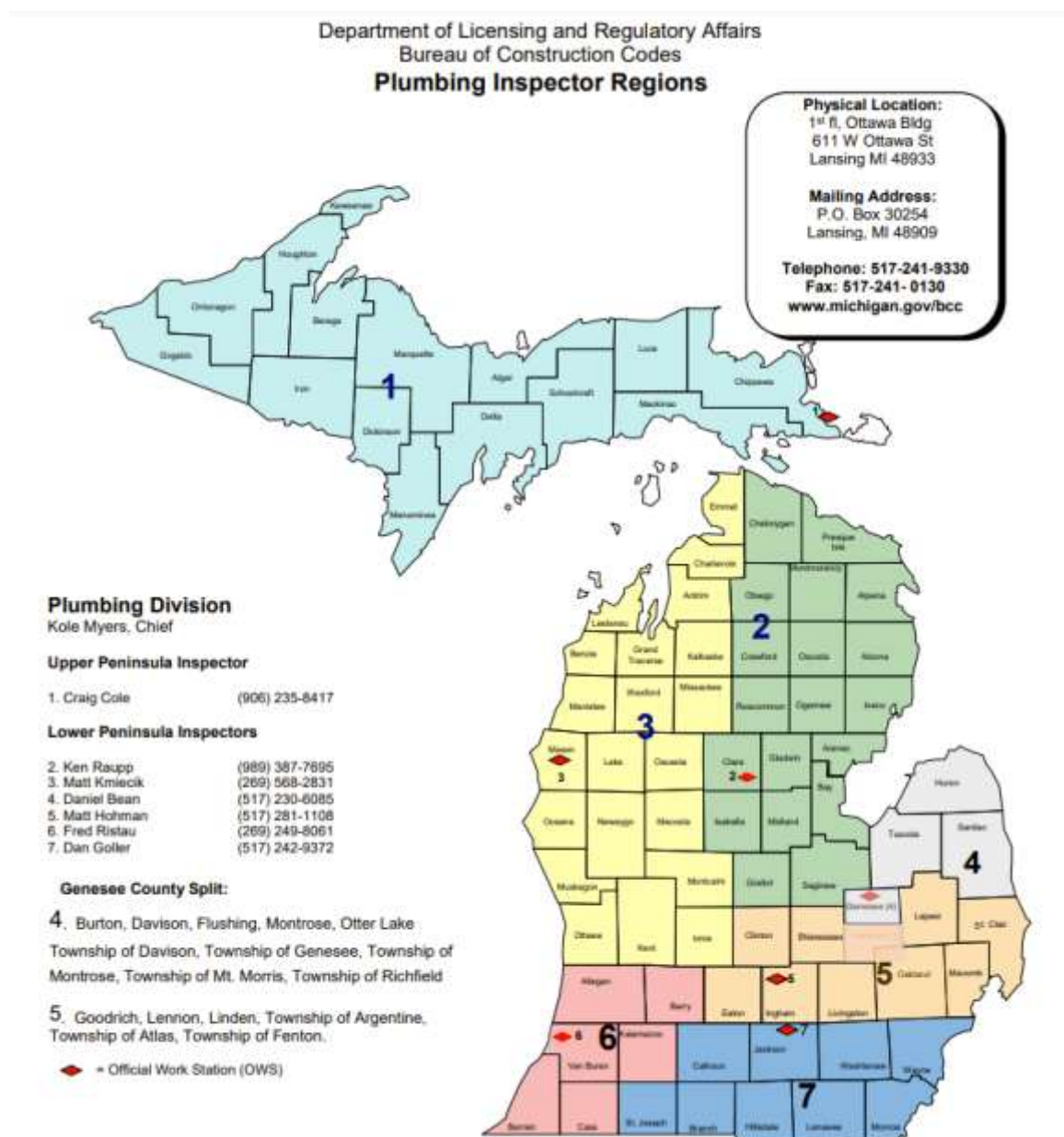

VP Legislative —Luciana Kayo

I am excited to start in my new position as a VP Legislative and in the future newsletters I will try to break down some Code sections and include updates from the **2018 Michigan Plumbing Code** that has been in effect since about a year ago.

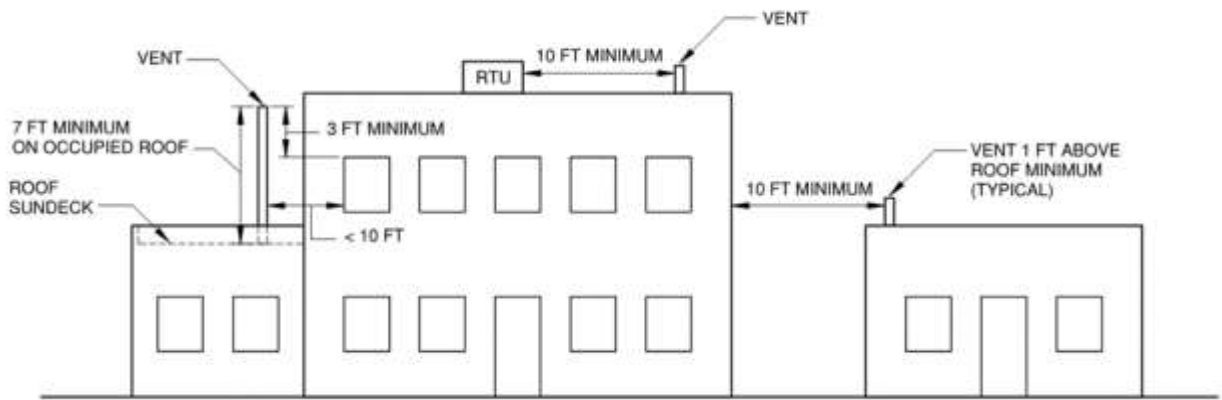
This month I am going over a few sections from **Chapter 9 Vents** and I have included images to facilitate understanding what all those words mean. These sections were also in the 2015 version of the Code, but I thought it would be good a refresher.

903.1 Roof extension. In the State of Michigan, open vent pipes shall extend at least 1 foot above roof. The minimum vent termination height is determined by the local jurisdiction based on snowfall rates, so that vent openings are not blocked by snow and to allow enough space for flashing. Therefore, if you end up doing projects in other States, check local vent requirements!

Where the roof is occupied, such as terrace or sundeck, plumbing vent pipe shall extend not less than 7 feet above the roof. The 7 feet minimum is to disperse sewer gases above the occupied area.

903.2 Frost closure. Besides the 3 inch minimum opening for the vent terminal, this section also states that any increase in pipe diameter must occur inside the building structure. This is to prevent that smaller than 3-inch pipes do not close up to frost due to very low temperatures.

903.5 Location of vent terminal. Vent terminals shall not be located within 10 feet horizontally from any air intake openings, operable windows, or beneath doors, except if they are located 3 feet or more above the top of such opening.

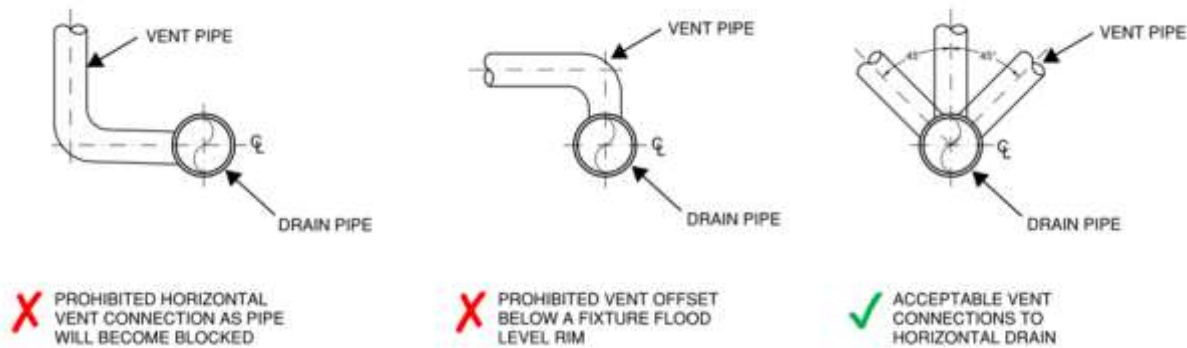

903.7 Extensions outside a structure. This section requires that a vent installed outside where temperature can be below 0oF, be provided with insulation, heat, or both to prevent buildup of frost inside the vent piping.

905.3 Vent connection to drainage system. Although this section clearly states that dry vents shall be connected above the centerline of a horizontal drainage pipe, it is not uncommon to find vent piping configurations as shown in the two images on the left.
