This updated standard applies to engineered siphonic roof drainage systems designed to operate full-bore through proper pipe sizing and siphonic roof drains. It establishes minimum performance requirements, provides inspection and testing guidelines, and outlines the fundamentals of system design.

Last revised in 2018, the new edition underwent a comprehensive update through ASPE's ANSI-accredited standards process, incorporating extensive feedback from across the plumbing design industry. Working Group 45 and ASPE's Main Design Standards Committee collaborated closely to ensure the revised standard aligns with today's industry needs and regulations.

Water Testing and Analysis: Iron, Manganese, Hydrogen Sulfide, & Tannins.

How to Test for These Contaminants that Stain and Make Your Water Smell:

Iron: in the Midwest, the most common contaminant for stains and smells is iron. It wrecks clothing, plumbing fixtures, and clogs pipes. *It is best tested on-site or within 24 to 48 hours after the sample is drawn. It is tested in parts per million. Anything over .4 ppm will stain.*

Manganese: it is not nearly as necessary to test for Manganese unless we're getting into pool water filtration because an Iron filter will generally remove a majority of the Manganese as well. *It is also tested in parts per million.*

Hydrogen Sulfide: this gas smells like rotten eggs and needs to be tested on-site with Alka-Seltzer™ and a Color Pad. *If the pad turns color, Hydrogen Sulfide is present and it will take different media to remove it.*

Tannins: these are generally tested on-site in a white cup. If the water is dirty, you typically have tannins. If we suspect it is tainted, we send the water in for further analysis to confirm. *This takes a different type of equipment media to remove the tannins which are commonly associated with surface water and shallow wells. A lot of stench and staining comes from decaying vegetation.*

Iron and associated contaminants are the hardest to treat thoroughly, sometimes it takes two pieces of equipment to remove all of the Iron and prevent staining - an Iron Filter and a Water Softener.

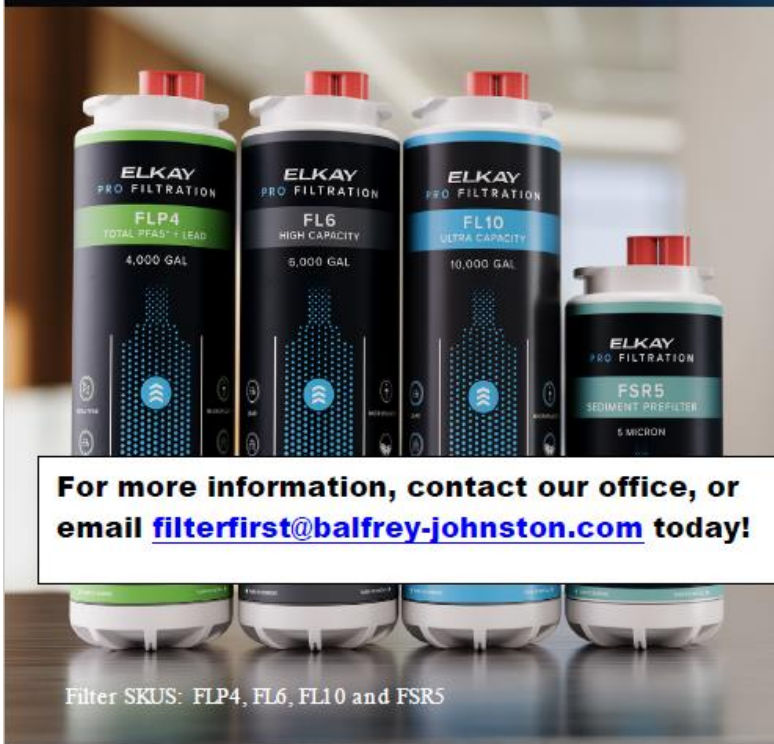
